**Committee Reports**

*Finance* – In Jim Wise’s absence, Mike Clark presented the quarterly financial report.

*Worship* – Shelly Smith reported that the Worship Committee will meet in February to make plans for the Lent season. Shelly thanked the congregation for helping in many ways during the Advent season.

*Membership* – Mary Plummer reported that a church photo directory will be produced later this year. The committee will host quarterly birthday parties again this year.

*Outreach* – Susan Lutzke reported that the congregation donated 152 pounds of food to the Interchurch Food Pantry of Johnson County. The Outreach Committee is making plans for a new service project. Shari Stark will lead this year’s PCC Relay For Life team. Susan thanked the congregation for its generosity in giving food, time, and resources for multiple projects.

*Youth* – Pastor Steve reported that Zach Vaught is interested in beginning a Bible study for high school students, college students, young adults.

*Trustees* – In Eddy Smith’s absence, George Burton reported that the Trustees are handling snow removal, reinstalled a loose light cover in the Sanctuary, and bled the valve on the hot water heater to increase heat flow to the Nursery. Shelly Smith asked about sealing the back window in the Sanctuary because concrete dust is coming through the window. George said this could be a major project.
