If you are interested in being a model in the fashion show, please see Connie Clark.

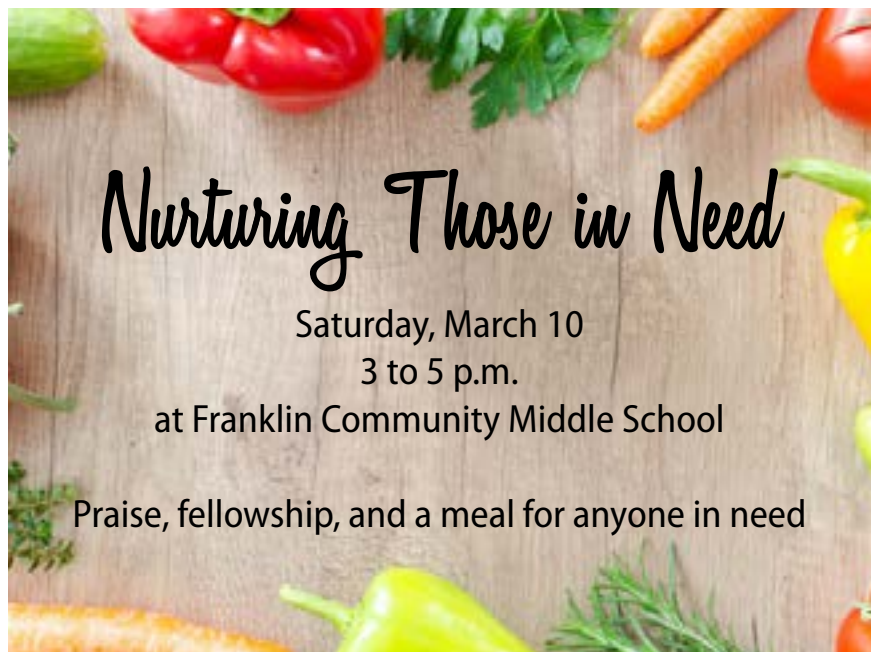
Nurturing Those in Need
