25 people were in attendance.

**Committee Reports**

*Finance* – Jim Wise presented the quarterly financial report. He reported that we received notification that PCC will receive \$15,000 from the Rosemary Deer estate. Mike Clark reported that funeral meal donations totaled about \$700.

*Education* – The committee suggested offering coffee, donuts, and a printed devotion in the Fellowship Hall for anyone who arrives after Sunday School begins but before the Worship Service begins, beginning May 6. Julie Burton will coordinate the details.

*Pastoral Relations* – Cathy Sledge made a motion to extend a summer internship to Hunter Chadwell if he submits an application letter. Shelly Smith seconded the motion. The motion passed.

*Outreach* – The committee is seeking members for PCC's Relay For Life team. Several fundraising events are planned for Relay For Life, including Chicago's Pizza gift cards, a Family Game Night, and an Italian dinner.

*Memorial* – Judy Eldridge reported that the total amount in the Memorial Fund is \$9,428.77. Recent purchases include a new sink/faucet for the kitchen from the Norman Findley Fund, a new computer and trashcans from the Rosemary Deer Fund, and round tables and piano tuning from the Mark Clem Fund.

*Trustees* – Eddy Smith reported that George Burton, Eddy Smith, and John Zeilinga installed the new sink and faucet in the kitchen; John Zeilinga hung new wallpaper in the downstairs restroom; and John Zeilinga replaced the mats in the kitchen. Judy Eldridge said there is a broken picnic table at the Shelter House.

*Elders* – Vince Barr reported that the Elders paused their visitations due to visitation restrictions in local hospitals, but since the restrictions have been lifted, the Elders' visitations will resume.

*Pastor Steven Sorensen* – Pastor Steve presented his written report.

**New Business**

*Community Yard Sale* – Mary Plummer suggested hosting a community yard sale, which includes selling booth space in our parking lot and selling food from the Shelter House. Sandy Hoagland suggested creating a special committee for this project. The idea will be considered for next summer.

*Storage Area* – Judy Eldridge suggested getting rid of the old folding chairs and boxes in the downstairs storage area.
