24 people were in attendance.

Committee Reports

Finance – Jim Wise presented the quarterly financial report.

Evangelism – Mike and Connie Clark reported that the committee's first priority is replacing the sign at State Road 135. The committee also is investigating bulk mailings to surrounding neighborhoods.

Outreach – Susan Lutzke thanked the congregation for its support of the Outreach Committee and its activities. Susan reported that the Cub Pantry (the food pantry that serves Franklin Community School Corporation) will support PCC's Blessing Box by providing some popular items each month.

Memorial – Judy Eldridge reported that the committee has decided to purchase four hand sanitizer stations to install throughout the church.

Youth – Susan Lutzke reported that she will turn her weekly youth Sunday School lesson into a devotion that she will mail to the families each Monday.

Trustees – Eddy Smith reported Kevin Thompson is plowing the parking lot.

Pastor Steven Sorensen – Pastor Steve presented his written report.

New Business

Community Yard Sale – Judy Eldridge reported that Christian Women's Fellowship would like to host a community yard sale. The sale will be open to the Providence community at large, and CWF will charge participants for a space in the sale. The sale will use the parking lot and the Shelter House. The event is scheduled for Saturday, June 1. Judy asked permission from the Board to host this event. Sandy Hoagland made a motion to approve the sale. Andy Findley seconded the motion. The motion passed.

New Sign on State Road 135 – Mike Clark reported that the Evangelism Committee and others have reviewed estimates and designs for a new sign on State Road 135. The sign will cost between \$1,200 and \$1,600, and we will save between \$350 and \$500 by installing the sign ourselves. The funds for the sign will come from the Norman Findley Memorial Fund. Mike made a motion for the Evangelism Committee to design, purchase, and install a sign while consulting with the Findley family and the owner of the land. Julie Burton seconded the motion. Shelly Smith recommended including solar lighting on the sign. Mike said the committee is open to all suggestions. The motion passed.
