Missions - Serving His world

CSI MATCHING VEHICLE FUND

CSI relies on good construction vehicles for her mission fields. On the Belize mission field, a truck donated by Kenneth & Judy Eldridge years ago remains in use. Dependable vehicles keep mission teams busy.

The construction vehicle in Jamaica has reached a point where it really needs to be replaced. Jamaican Construction Coordinator, Patrick, has a lot of homes which need to be built along the roads and back in the bush. The current truck in Jamaica needs replacing due to its age and many miles.

CSI has a Matching Vehicle Fund with CSI Ministries Jamaica. They are nearing the goal but need additional funds to get to the match. Gifts may be sent to CSI Ministries Inc., 840 Daniel Drive, Kokomo, IN 46901.

Jamaicans say in Patois, "Every-mickle-mek-a-muckle." The translation is "Every little bit helps out and will lead to something significant!" Mike Ginter is the Field Director for CSI Ministries, Jamaica.

DR. MARY RUTH WISE

On May 6th, 1953, sixty-six years ago, Mary Ruth Wise and mission partner Martha Duff made their first journey into the foothills of the Andes Mountains to begin their linguistic fieldwork with the Yanesha people. A journey that



began that day eventually has taken Dr. Mary Ruth to 11 countries as a consultant and editor for other fieldworkers.

In May of 1953, the two missionaries landed in a small float plane at the village of Shethomaso on the Palcazu River in Peru. The first Ya-

nesha word they learned was tse'm (buzzard) as one flew overhead.

Friendly Yanesha women walked with them up the cliff to the village. Through the work done by Mary Ruth and Martha, a Yanesha New Testament translation was completed in 1976 and published in 1978.

Today vibrant Yanesha churches are served by pastors and these churches anxiously await the completion of the Old Testament in their own language. Providence Christian Church continues to play a small part in financing the work of the translation.
